Phil is a retiree of the Indiana University Cyclotron facility, and was a patient at IUHPTC himself. He is very aware of the personal needs of patients and their caregivers during their stay in Bloomington. Phil, through his church, Sherwood Oaks, created HoosiersCare to offer affordable housing, encouragement and personal associations to help make your stay more pleasant.

We presently operate two comfortable individual residences in the Bloomington area. The rate is \$30 per day to help us cover operating costs. We invite all to consider Sherwood Oaks Christian Church their church family while in Bloomington--making available the opportunity to meet other families in our community. Please feel free to join us on Wednesday nights September through May, at 5:15pm for a good, old-fashioned home cooked meal--as our guests.

Participation in SOCC activities is not at all required.
